Masyu (Crosslink) by Murat Can Tonta Theme: Antisymmetry

Rules: Variation of Masyu. The loop may pass through a cell twice, but only if the loop goes straight through that cell both times. The loop still cannot coincide anywhere except for these single cell crossings.

If the loop passes through a white circle twice, then it must obey the normal rules by turning at one or both of the adjacent cells in the loop both times.

(Implicitly, the loop cannot pass through a black circle twice as that would require passing straight through a black circle which is not allowed.)
