







14/03/05: Loop the Loops by Prasanna Seshadri Theme: Quadrants

Rules: Combination of Slitherlink and Masyu Rules. (Draw a single closed loop by connecting neighboring dots horizontally or vertically so that each number represents the number of adjacent edges used by the loop. The loop passes through all circles. It must go straight through the white circles with at least one side turning at the next dot; it must turn at the black circles and then go straight through the next dot in both directions.)

Deformable Masyu by Serkan Yurekli Theme: Clue Symmetry and Logic

Rules: Standard Masyu Rules. Also, some white circles may be shaded to become black circles.



14/03/07: Slitherlink (Sheep and Wolves) by Hans van Stippent

Rules: Standard Slitherlink rules. Also, all sheep (marked by an S) must be inside the loop and all wolves (marked by a W) must be outside the loop.
