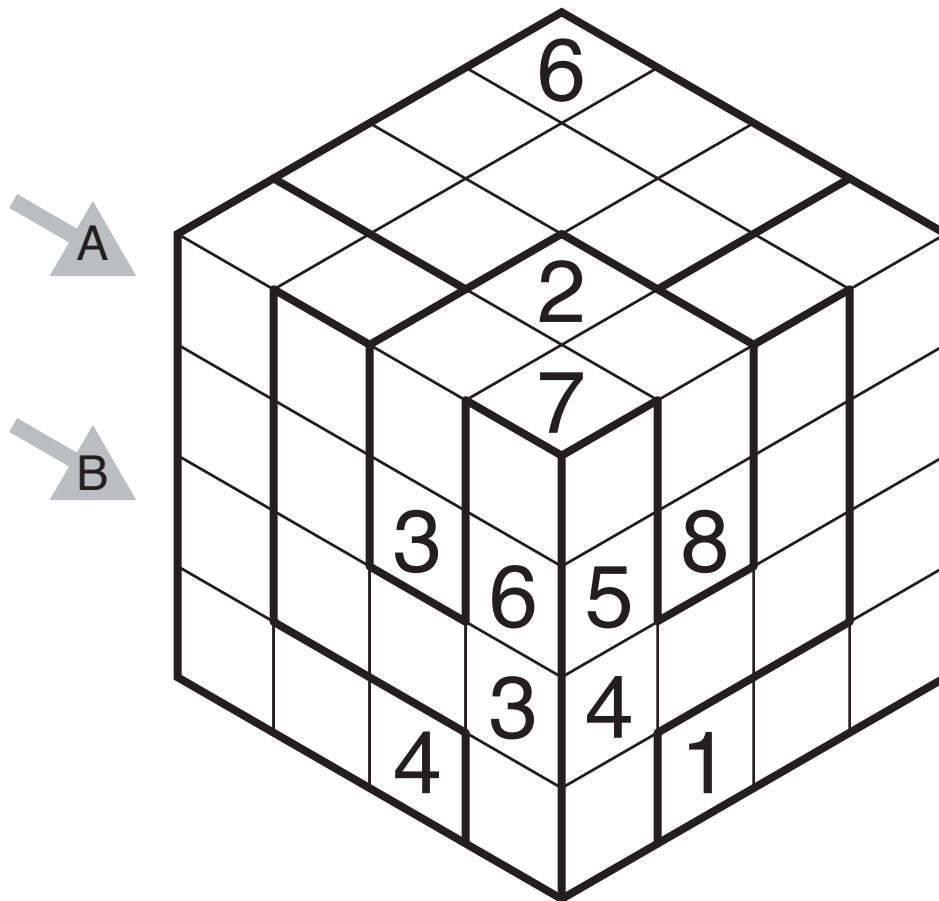

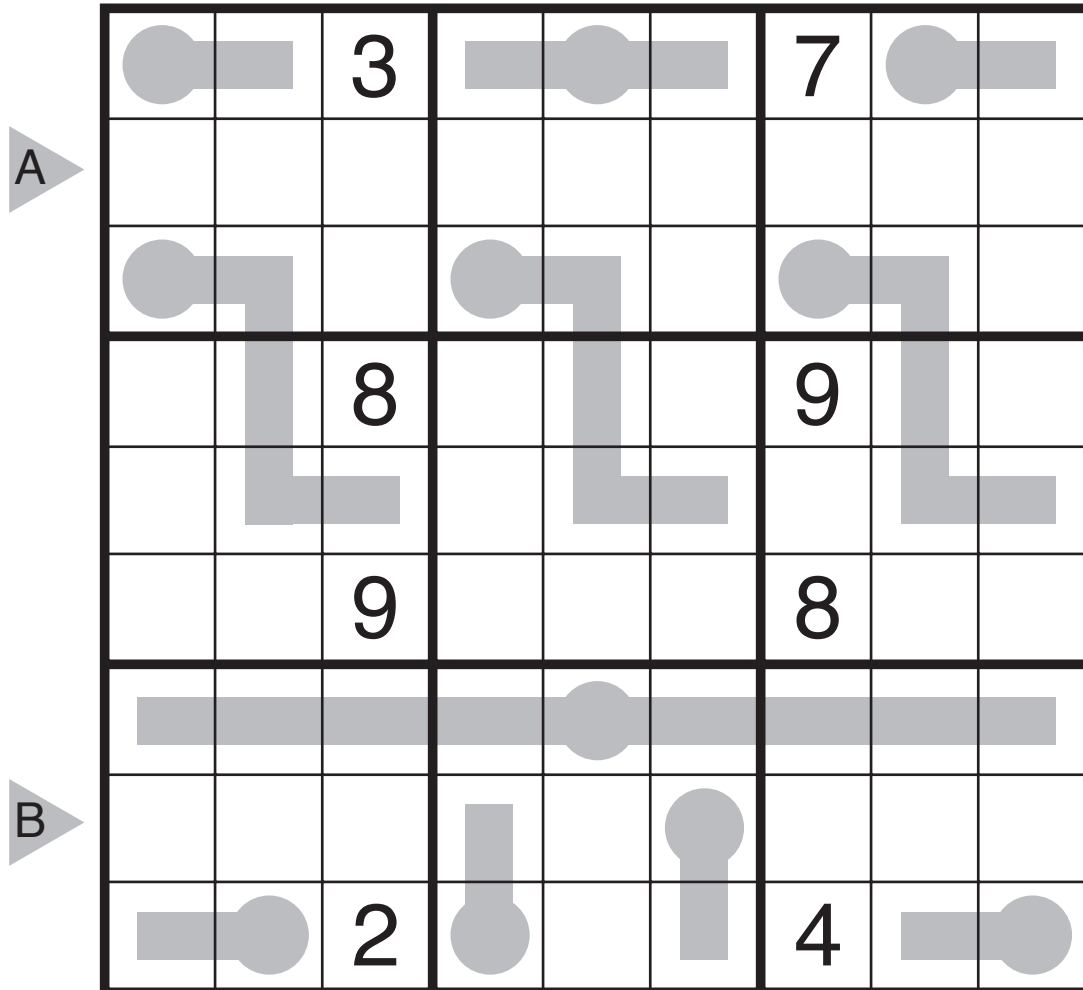
Not all gray circles are given; adjacent cells without a circle may contain either consecutive numbers or nonconsecutive numbers.
