Consecutive Pairs Sudoku by Thomas Snyder

Theme: World Sudoku Championship (WSC)

Rules: Standard Sudoku rules. Additionally, if a gray circle is given between two adjacent cells, then the two numbers in those cells must be consecutive. (Note: not all gray circles are given; adjacent cells without a circle may contain either consecutive numbers or nonconsecutive numbers.)

Sudoku with Dutch Snake by Serkan Yürekli Theme: Clue Symmetry and Logic

Rules: Standard Sudoku rules. Additionally, locate a snake (a 1-cell wide path) that connects the gray circles marked with 1 and 9. The snake cannot touch itself, even diagonally. All cells marked with white circles must be part of the snake. Along the path, the snake must pass straight through any cell with an odd number from the sudoku, and must make a 90-degree turn in any cell with an even number from the sudoku.

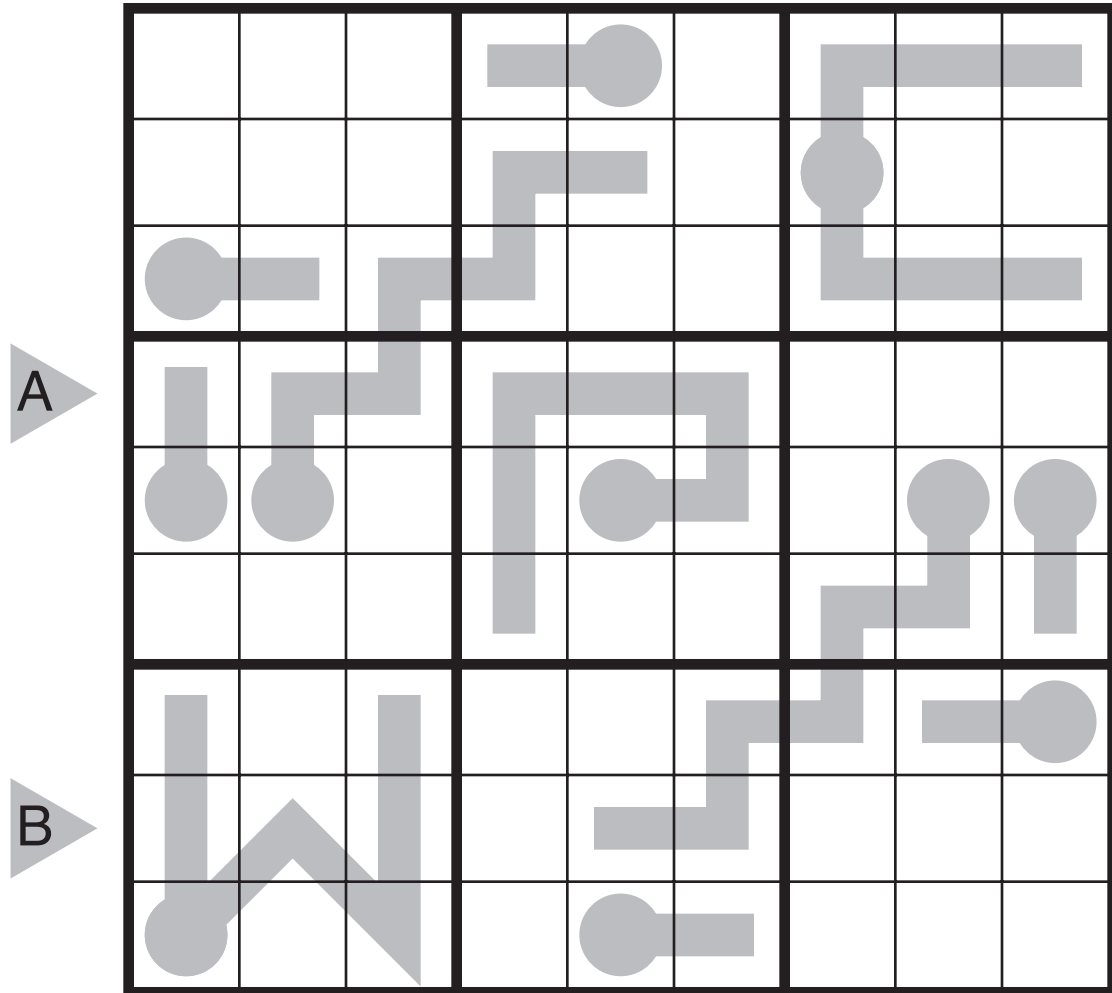
