# A/B TESTING Solution

## Puzzles by Thomas Snyder

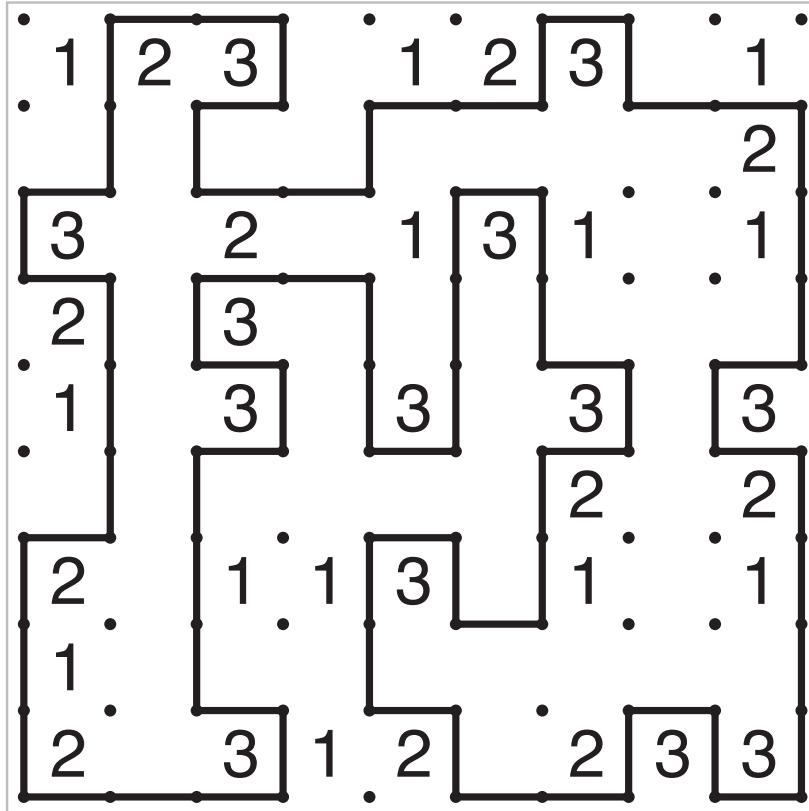
All puzzles are formatted in the standard way as on Grandmaster Puzzles and the titles give enumerations of the two styles represented as confirmation.

By logic, one of the pieces (A or B) in one of four possible rotations can be placed into each grid to complete each pair of puzzles. Once everything is solved, the puzzles can be ordered from small to big (the five pairs have unique sizes) and by the A piece before the B piece, as hinted by the figure on the cover sheet.

Taking the “answer submission” value, applying the indicated arithmetic, and converting to alphanumeric yields the answer, MORNING JOE.
