Basement Skyscraper Sudoku by Hans van Stippent

Rules: Combination of Skyscrapers and Sudoku, with the additional variation that gray cells are “underground” and cannot be seen (think of them as starting with a negative sign if necessary).

As an example, the 4 in row 2 means that four buildings are visible from column 3 to column 7 in that row, even if a 9 is in one of the first two columns.
