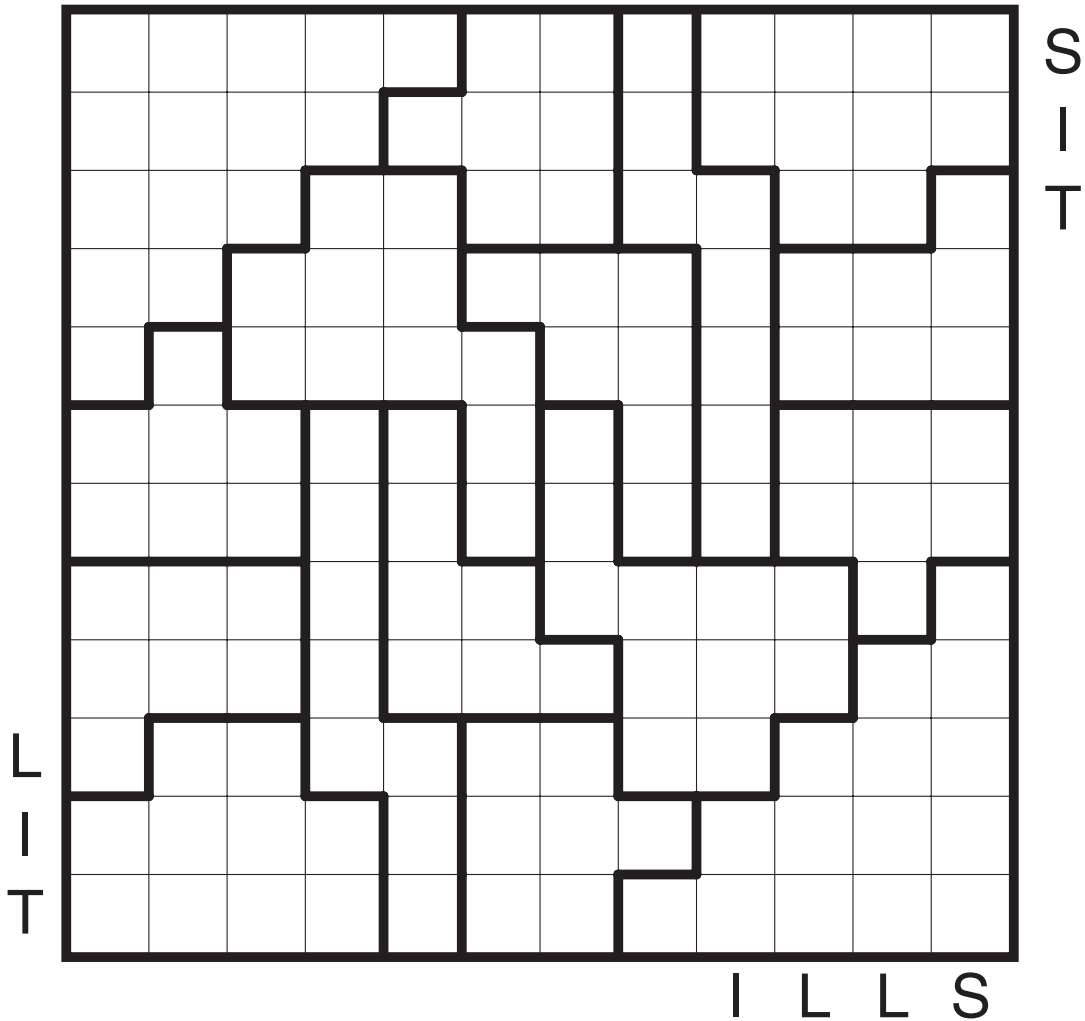
Rules: Standard LITS Rules.
