

Subsets Sudoku by Philip Newman

Rules: Insert a number from 1 to 9 into each cell so that no number repeats in any row, column, or bold region. For each pair of cages connected by a zigzag line, the set of numbers in the smaller cage must fully appear in the larger cage. Any number on the connecting zigzag line must also be a part of the larger cage but cannot be a part of the smaller cage. Numbers do not repeat within cages. (For example: The numbers in R4C123 (small cage) and R5C3 (connecting line) must appear in the five-cell cage R67C3+R8C345.)
