Parity Sweeper Sudoku by clover!

Standard Sudoku rules (insert a number from 1 to 9 into each cell so that no number repeats in any row, column, or bold region). A circled number indicates the total count of surrounding cells (up to 8) that must have the same parity (i.e., odd or even) as the circled number. For example, if a 3 is circled, there must be exactly 3 odd numbers in the surrounding 8 cells and the other 5 cells must contain even numbers.
