

Anti-King Consecutive Pairs Sudoku by Philip Newman

Rules: Insert a number from 1 to 9 into each cell so that no number repeats in any row, column, or bold region. Also, cells sharing a corner cannot contain the same number (as if adding a chess king's move constraint to each cell). Also, if a white circle is given between two adjacent cells, then the two numbers in those cells must differ by 1. Pairs of cells without circles can have any relationship.
