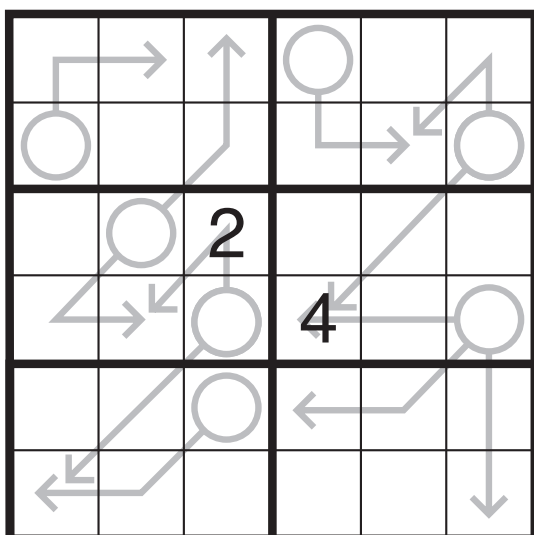
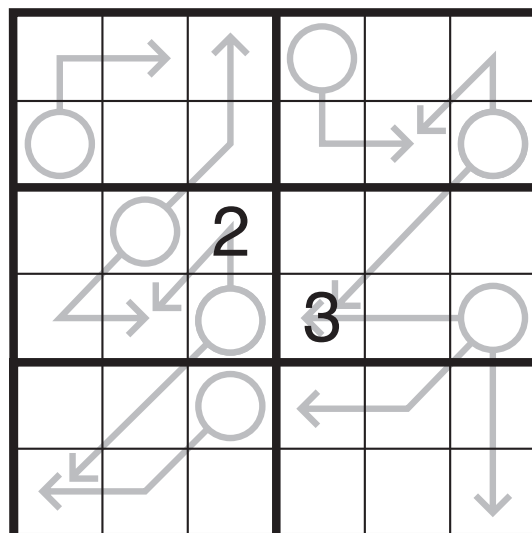
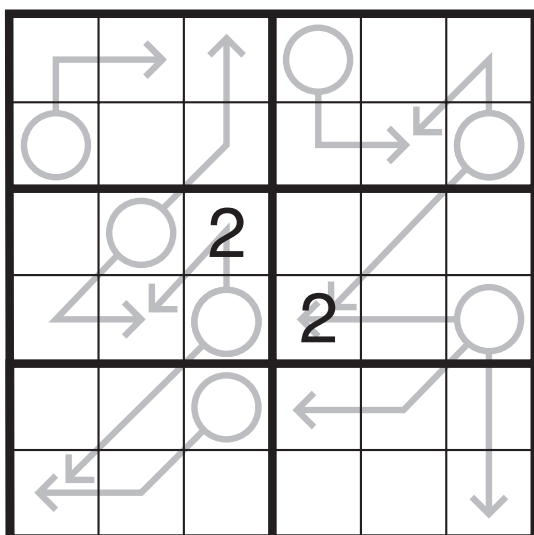


Arrow Sudoku by Philip Newman

Rules: Standard Sudoku rules (insert a number from 1 to 6 into each cell so that no number repeats in any row, column, or bold region). Some arrow shapes are in the grid; the sum of the numbers along the path of each arrow must equal the number in the circled cell. Numbers can repeat within an arrow shape.

Note: Grid “22” is much more difficult than “23” and “24” despite similar appearances.
