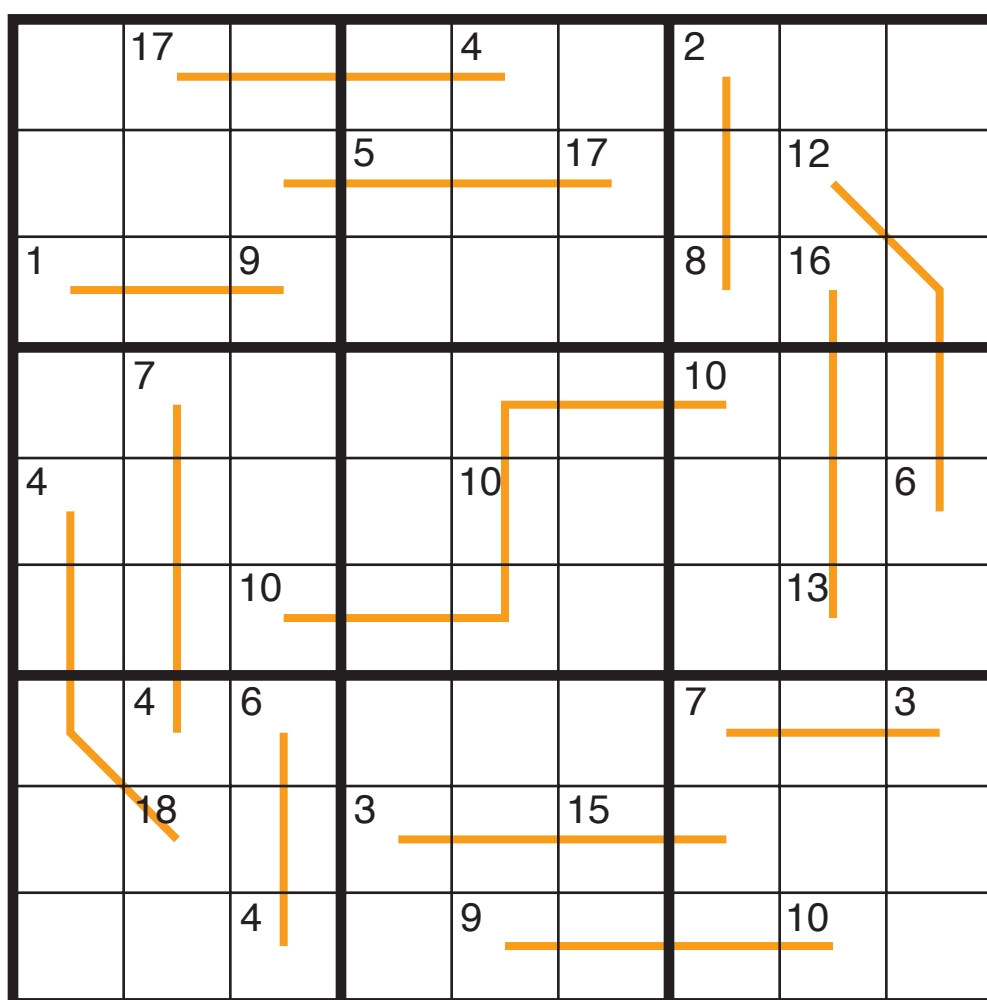


Killer Sudoku by Philip Newman

Rules: Insert a number from 1 to 9 into each cell so that no number repeats in any row, column, or bold region. Also, divide each line into subsections so that each cell on the line belongs to exactly one subsection, and each subsection contains exactly one number clue. Each subsection acts as a Killer cage: values in a subsection cannot repeat and must sum to the total given by that subsection's number clue. (Numbers *can* repeat on a line if allowed by other rules, as long as those numbers are in different subsections.)
