

Twin Detector Sudoku by Bill Murphy

Standard Sudoku rules (insert a number from 1 to 9 into each cell so that no number repeats in any row, column, or bold region). Arrows in the grid indicate that there is a run of cells in the given direction that sums to the number in the cell containing the arrow, starting from the first cell seen by the arrow. Not all arrows are given. (E.g., because R4C2 has an up arrow, either R3C2, R3C2 + R2C2, or R3C2 + R2C2 + R1C2 must sum to the value in R4C2 = 4.)
